An ISVA is someone who is here for you. They are not a Police Officer, Social Worker, or a teacher. An ISVA is someone who wants to help you have your voice heard.

Sometimes speaking to adults like the Police or Social Workers may seem scary or confusing, even when we know they are there to help. We can help to explain why they may need to talk to you, and about what may happen next.

There are no silly questions. If something is bothering you or making you feel confused or worried, we will try to help.

- We won't make you do or talk about anything you don't want to.
- We will always listen to you, and try to help. We want you to feel safe.
- We may ask about how you're feeling today, and what you enjoy doing.
- If you have questions about what may happen next, your ISVA can help to find out the answers for you.



- Whenever you speak to your ISVA we won't tell other people what you have said.
- We will only need to say something to someone else, if you ask us to, or if we are worried that you or someone else may be in trouble, or could be hurt.
- Your safety, and other people's safety is very important to us.



- Your ISVA can see you face to face, to chat and make things like craft or just to chill out and have a bit of quiet time.
- If you like to speak on the phone, your ISVA can call you or could meet up over Zoom.
- We will make plan with you and your parent/carer about when and where you can meet up. You can choose if you want to see your ISVA or not.
 - We want you to know that your voice is very important.
