Responding to

**Therapy, Support, Advocacy,
Prevention and Outreach**

Yellow Door are a friendly, non-judgemental charity specialising in supporting people who have experienced, or are at risk of, domestic or sexual abuse.

We are a Southampton based service offering a range of free prevention, advocacy and support, covering the majority of Southampton and Hampshire.

Adult Therapeutic Services

This provides individual specialist counselling sessions and support, as well as therapeutic and psycho-educational groups to those who have suffered sexual abuse at any point in their lives.

Children & Young People's Services

Specialist support for 18 years or under in need of help following experiences of domestic and/or sexual abuse.

Family Therapy

The team work with various family units where one or more members have experienced or are at risk of abuse.

Frankie Service

The service will provide counselling to those aged 0-18 years, and play therapy for children who are victims of sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or female genital mutilation.

Gender Identity Therapy Service

Support for young people and their families with concerns or difficulties regarding the young persons gender identity.

Domestic Abuse Services

Our team provides expert support to survivors of domestic abuse through delivery of psychoeducational programmes for women and children. Our team work closely with local partners and offer a variety of training packages.

Diversity and Inclusion Advocacy (DIA)

This service offers tailored, needs-led help who face barriers to them accessing support, improve access and promote equality and inclusion. Our DIA team provides training to communities, groups and professionals.

Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (ISVA)

Specialises in practical, non-judgmental support and advocacy following any type of sexual abuse / violence, including support around reporting to the police and throughout the criminal justice process. This service covers Hampshire.
